Coffee & Delicacies

- **Brooklyn Ice Cream Factory (white wooden house)** ①

Fulton Ferry Pier Landing
Artisanal ice cream offered in the old fire station.

- **Dough** ②

55 Water St (between Dock st and Main st) within the Food Court.
Promises you a unique experience: taste doughnuts

- **Brooklyn Historical Society (memorabilia)** ①

128 Pierrepont St, (corner with Clinton st)
Memories of Brooklyn.

- **AEGIR** ②

99 Water St.
Skate shop and accessories that might appeal to children.
Possibility of taking courses on 1 hour sessions with loan of equipment



where to eat ?

- **Shake Shack (Burgers)** ①
1 old Fulton st (angle with Water st)
Quality fast food

- **Grimaldi's Pizza** ③
1 Front St (angle with Fulton st)
One of NYC's hottest pizzerias but requiring a little waiting

- **Luke's Lobster (Lobster Sandwich)** ④
11 Water st (angle with Fulton st)
Go try the lobster roll (lobster sandwich),



to discover

- **Brooklyn Historical Society DUMBO** ①

55 Water St (between Dock st and Main st).
This is the opportunity to discover this old industrial building and see cool exhibits on Brooklyn.

- **Jane's Carousel** ③

45 Dock St
Protected by a glass wall designed by Jean Nouvel, it is the Carousel with a view of the Brooklyn Bridge to offer your children.

- **New York Transit Museum**
99 Schermerhorn (between Boerum pl and Court st). ②
Located in an authentic metro station, you will be able to test their evolution since 1907. The shop will also be an opportunity to bring back souvenirs from NY.
