
75 Rockfeller Plaza and W 51th st. The temple of the doll.

• MoMA (Museum of Modern Art) @

• Summit One Vanderbilt (observatory) • 45E 42nd St (next to Grand central station)
Observatory opened in early 2022. It offers an exceptional view in the heart of Midtown (Chrysler Building, Empire State Building...). It is designed in a playful and very "instagrammable" way, guaranteed effect on the photos.
