## Midtown Course

Below is a selection of addresses. The target is family. The goal is to offer you a few places that are accessible to the family and generally quite typical of NYC or the United States. Regarding restaurants, I also tried to select places that were not too expensive.



### Shopping

- **American Girl Place (doll)** ①  
75 Rockefeller Plaza and W 51th st.  
The temple of the doll.
- **M & M's World** ②  
1600 Broadway (between 48th st and 49th st).  
Store in the effigy of the famous peanut coated with chocolate (candies, gadgets ...).
- **FAO Schwartz (toys)** ③  
Rockefeller Plaza and 49th st.  
Famous toy store.
- **Harry Potter** ④  
935 Broadway (derrière le Flatiron building)  
Magasin à l'effigie du célèbre sorcier. 3 étages offrant articles, décors de cinéma et jeux (réalité virtuelle)



### where to eat ?

- **Five Guys (burger)** ①  
36 W 48th st (between 5th and 6th av).  
Delicious burgers, prepared on demand.
- **Carmine's (Italian)** ②  
200 W 44th st (between 7th and 8th).  
Italian restaurant, ideal for family meals. Some dishes on the menu are to share.
- **Pershing square café (American restaurant)** ③  
90 E 42nd st - Grand Central  
Practical and warm address open all day. You can eat pancakes, omelets, bagels as well as burgers.
- **the Halal Guys (street food)** ④  
w 53rd st and 6th av.  
A street food brand to test.

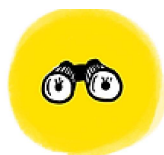

- **Top of the rock (observatory)** ①

30 Rockefeller plaza.  
It is the observatory of the Rockefeller center. It  
allows you to enjoy the architecture of Midtown  
with a view of Central Park and the Empire State  
Building.

- **MoMA (Museum of Modern Art)** ②

11 West 53rd st (between 5th and 6th av)  
One of the most important Museum of Modern Art  
in the world. MoMA offers a rich collection of  
paintings, sculptures, and other works. Great  
masters such as Gauguin, Van Gogh, Picasso,  
Matisse ... are exhibited there.

- **A show on Broadway (show)** ③

In Theater District and Times Square, go see a show.  
The experience is twofold, enjoy a famous Broadway  
show and the Times square district with its illuminated  
panels.

- **Summit One Vanderbilt (observatory)** ④

45E 42nd St (next to Grand central station)  
Observatory opened in early 2022. It offers an  
exceptional view in the heart of Midtown (Chrysler  
Building, Empire State Building...). It is designed in a  
playful and very "instagrammable" way, guaranteed  
effect on the photos.
